Student Research Prize Wednesday 21th March 2018

Cardiff Medical Society invites applications from Medical Students studying in Wales to present their research findings. This may have been done as part of a student selected component to their course, as part of a BSc or a specialist interest project. The applicant must have made a significant contribution to the design and writing of the research project being presented. Quantitative and qualitative research submissions are both welcome.

The best abstracts will be selected for presentation at the March meeting of Cardiff Medical Society. Abstracts will be judged on:

- General Interest;
- scientific content;
- presentation of data; and
- importance/ impact.

Successful applicants will be invited to make an oral presentation to the monthly meeting at 7.30pm at Dental Lecture Theatre, University Hospital of Wales on Wednesday 21st March 2018.

Each presentation and any subsequent questions will last for about 10 minutes. Depending on the level of interest and subject matter, 4 to 6 applicants will be invited to present. At the end of the evening a panel from the audience will assess each presentation. There will be a prize for everyone who makes a presentation. In addition, the first, second and third ranked presentations will be awarded £250, £150 and £100 respectively.

Please submit a structured abstract of not more than 350 words in length under the following headings: (1) Title, (2) Author(s) (3) Background, (4) Methodology, (5) Results, and (6) Conclusions.
